

Urban C-ITS Contest: Rules of Engagement

1. Submission procedure

For the submission of the C-ITS deployment description, please note the following instructions:

- The C-ITS deployment description should be submitted via e-mail, to the following address: **joao.montenegro@armis.pt**
- The submissions shall occur from **May 2nd to July 17th** at 23:59 (CET);
- The description of the C-ITS service implementations must be provided in English;
- The submission must include the information in the format of the C-ITS deployment description template (Annex 1) and must be completed with a submission sheet (Annex 2), which provides some information to identify the represented city, along with the awards for which the city intends to apply for.
- Both annexes are attached to the “Call for City Forum and Urban C-ITS contest” e-mail

2. List of awards and evaluation criteria

As there shall be an award ceremony (described in section 5), each of the following categories will be subjected to an award, according to pre-established criteria. Most of the award criteria are following the SUMP (Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan) goals.

Table 1 contains the list of awards, as well as the specific criteria that will be used to evaluate each of them.

4. Further rules and observations/remarks

It is worth noting the following:

- Any intellectual property developed during the contest remains the participants' property.
- The evaluation shall be finalized and sent via e-mail to the participating cities by the 15th of September 2023 and contain the information regarding the winning cities for each award.
- Although the City Forum (previous day event) admits the possibility of a group of cities to presenting their deployments, for the C-ITS contest event, cities will be evaluated individually. Therefore, the C-ITS description template must be filled out and submitted by a single city.

5. Award ceremony

Following the development and evaluation, there will be an award ceremony in the city of Porto, Portugal. Although all participants of the event are welcome and encouraged to attend the ceremony, a virtual option will also be made available to allow greater integration.

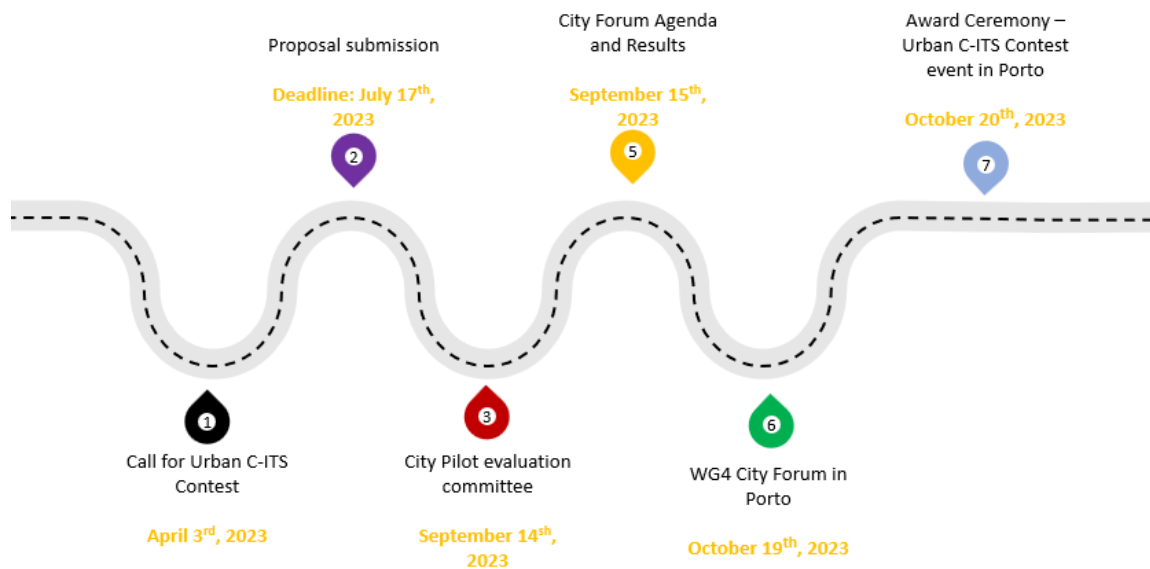


Figure 1 - Timeline for the Urban C-ITS contest event

Based on the information provided throughout this document, a timeline is provided in Figure 1, with the view to enhance the understanding of the rollout of the event.
